The 120th Annual State Convention of the PA Knights of Columbus will take place from May 4-6, 2018. The convention will be held at the Hilton Harrisburg, 1 North Second Street, Harrisburg, PA.

Hotel Registration

There are 2 ways of booking rooms before the cut-off date of April 6 or before the block sells out.

1. Online: Go to the Hilton Harrisburg booking link below and select the correct arrival dates when the link opens. https://secure3.hilton.com/en_US/hi/reservation/book.htm,
2. Telephone: Call into the Hilton Harrisburg reservation line at 717-233-6000 and select Option 1.

Tell the reservations specialist your group code is KC18 and give your arrival and departure dates.

The Hilton does NOT accept mail-in registrations. State Officers, Directors, Chairmen and District Deputies will be on the Master Billing List.

Friday and Saturday night room rates are all inclusive, to include room, occupancy and sales taxes, and 1 dinner and 1 breakfast per occupant (including taxes and gratuity).

Parking

Parking is \$10 per night, with unlimited in & out, for overnight guests staying in the Hilton.

Day Parkers rate is \$5.00 for 10 hours. The time starts as soon as you pull the ticket. No in & out. Ample parking is available and parking garage is directly connected to the hotel by ADA accessible elevators and covered hallways and ramps. Valet parking is also available for an extra fee.

The cost for Meal Tickets for those individuals not staying overnight or those needing extra tickets will be **\$25.00** for breakfast and **\$56.00** for dinner, which includes all taxes and gratuities. The **\$56.00** price also applies to Saturday's Convention Banquet. Tickets may be purchased in advance or at the Registration Table (Only limited quantities available at registration table).
