2 Retention Committee

We would prefer members stay Knights for the rest of their lives and be involved whenever they can. The yearly fee is relatively nominal and we will work with anyone who needs a waiver due to any hardship. However, if someone wishes to drop their membership or moves away, they need to inform us in writing. Not paying dues does not automatically forfeit membership and instead hurts the council financially. An insurance member can only be moved to “inactive” as membership is required on their policy.

Last October, we submitted 14 members to the Supreme membership office to be taken off our roster. Most of them had not paid dues in at least 3 years. 8 of them have now given us written notice to forfeit their membership, leaving us with only 1 refusing to respond to us and 5 with unknown forwarding addresses. Unfortunately, the national office has still not responded to this request, so it has been resubmitted.

Last week, we sent out “Knight Alerts” to 5 others who have not paid for several years and were contacted personally last Fall. If we do not receive a positive response by next Friday, we will be submitting a “Notice of Intent to Retain” which is the request to be at least taken off our “active” roster.

We had 4 others who have not paid for several years, but have promised to pay all their past dues. However, if we do not receive any payment from these individuals by the April 11th meeting, we’ll be sending out a “Knight Alert” to them as well.

Brother Knights,


